Simcoe County LINX Transit Service

Starting August 6, 2019 Simcoe County is launching two new LINX transit routes: Wasaga Beach to Barrie (Route 2) and Orillia to Barrie (Route 3), as well as assuming the existing Collingwood to Wasaga Beach Link (Route 4).

Stops in Clearview are located at the Clearview Administration Centre in Stayner and the Brentwood Community Centre.

Ridership will be free from August 6 to September 2, 2019.

Stop Signs at Milltown Road in Singhampton

Council approved Councillor McKechnie's Notice of Motion to install two extra stop signs at the corner of Milltown Road and Church Street in Singhampton, making it a 4-way stop.

A by-law will be brought forward at a future Council meeting before the signs can be installed.

Downtown Beautification

Council received report CS-040-2019 and authorized Staff to purchase planters, benches, bike racks, bollards and winter holiday decorations within the approved budget allocation and in consultation with the Stayner Chamber of Commerce, Creemore Business Association and Hall Boards.

Community Improvement Plan Grants

Council Approved four grants under the Community Improvement Plan which allows for up to 50% funding for façade improvements for commercial and industrial properties in the downtowns and settlement entrances.
