NVCA Draft Budget 2020

Nottawasaga Valley Conservation Authority (NVCA) CAO Doug Hevenor presented the draft 2020 budget. A 50% decrease in the provincial transfer payment from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNR) has resulted in a budget shortfall.

NVCA staff were able to absorb, cut expenditures and increase revenues to cover almost 75% of the shortfall and requested a contribution from Clearview to make up the difference. Council approved the NVCA's request for \$124,970 from Clearview Township for the 2020 operating budget.

Zoning By-law Amendment for a Boarding Kennel on Concession 6 Nottawasaga in Stayner

Council approved a Zoning By-law amendment to the Township of Clearview Zoning By-law 06-54 for 1550 Concession 6 Nottawasaga to allow a doggie day care and boarding kennel facility.

Centre Line Road Notice of Motion from Deputy Mayor Barry Burton

Deputy Mayor Barry Burton brought forth a Notice of Motion regarding speeding and safety concerns along Centre Line Road in Stayner.

Correspondence from residents Markie and Andrew Walker, who live on Centre Line Road near the intersection of County Road 9 and Centre Line Road, was included. The concern is an increase in vehicle traffic, vehicles travelling at excessive speeds and limited visibility of residential driveways to motorists travelling Centre Line Road.

Council directed staff to review and report back to Council with recommendations on how to reduce the speeding and other safety recommendations to make the road safer for residents entering and exiting their private driveways.
