Indemnification of Councillor Broderick

In accordance with Indemnification By-law 04-46, and an opinion from Jim McIntosh, Co-managing partner, Barriston Law LLP, council voted to indemnify Councillor Broderick for administrative court actions arising from duties carried out on behalf of the Township. Reimbursement costs will be provided by the Township's Insurance provider pending no contravention.

Sale of Surplus Auto-Extraction Equipment

Council approved the sale of surplus auto extraction equipment to the Adjala-Tosorontio Fire Department for \$6,000.

In 2019 Clearview Fire and Emergency Services purchased upgraded auto-extraction tools resulting in a surplus of equipment (1-TNT simo-pump, 1-spreader, 1-combi tool, 2-cutters and 4 hoses).

The surplus equipment was advertised for sale amongst the Simcoe County Fire Chief's Association where Adjala-Tosorontio expressed an interest and market value of \$6,000 was decided upon.
